Weed Coverage



The weed remove we purchased was used again this spring (thank you to Rick, Mike, Nigel and Gareth for doing the work) and has been as successful as the first

application. However with the low rainfall the levels of the lakes meant the dead weed had risen to the surface. So Nigel and Rick added the sluice gate into the waterfall and blocked off the lower lake gate, to encourage the water to rise (and it did) allowing them to release the water and allow the weed to flow through.



Strimming and trees

The strimming of the undergrowth has stopped for the summer but once autumn begins we will restart and hope this encourages some of the bulbs we planted at the start of the year to start poking their heads through. Although it is sad to lose trees and have to remove them for safety, it has opened up the lake views which is lovely to see
