#### Adderbury Parish Council Report for March 2022

**Meetings** – During March 2022, a meeting of the Parish Council was held at Church House, High Street, Adderbury on Tuesday 29 March 2022 and the Staffing Committee met on Thursday 24 March 2022. Copies of agendas and minutes are available on the PC web site. <u>www.adderburypc.co.uk</u>

During the month, Councillors also held meetings with regard to maintenance works in the village, grass cutting, traffic calming and works to the Milton Road Field.

**Parish Council Surgeries** – The next two surgeries are scheduled for the following dates, from 11am to 12 noon at Church House, High Street, Adderbury: Saturday 2 April 2022 & Saturday 7 May 2022.

**Vacancies** – There are two vacancies on the Parish Council and if residents would like information on becoming a Councillor, they should contact the Clerk or any of the current Councillors for more details. Two new Parish Councillors have been co-opted; Linda Thirzie-Smart and Rachel Moffat.

**Environment** - Please could residents remember to cut back hedges and trees which are overhanging footpaths and roads, as this creates a dangerous situation for drivers and pedestrians.

**Highways** - The Parish Council have submitted to the County Council for appropriate roads in the village to have a 20mph speed limit restriction. Main roads such as the B4100, A4260 and Milton Road are exempt from the initiative. The application is supported by County Councillor Arash Fatemian. A questionnaire has been circulated on Social Media and the PC website regarding the proposal and there are also questions about whether the proposed closure of the western arm of the oak tree junction (Horn Hill Road/Milton Road) should go ahead. A paper copy of the questionnaire can be obtained by contacting the Clerk to the Parish Council and it will also be produced in Contact. Please return all paper responses to Adderbury Stores or to Church House by 31 May 2022.

**Litter Pick** – The annual village litter pick is being held on Saturday 9 April 2022. Please meet outside the Coach and Horses at 10am. Equipment will be provided. Children should be accompanied by an adult.

### Residents of The Rise and parents dropping off/collecting from the Primary School are reminded not to park their vehicles on the green in The Rise, as it is an amenity area not a designated parking area. Parking on the green damages the grass, kerb stones and obstructs the grass cutting contractor from being able to maintain the grass.

For highways issues that do not require immediate action, residents are encouraged to use the Fix My Street app or complete an online form, available on the OCC web site.

Civil Parking Enforcement has been introduced by the County Council and it is expected that officers will monitor the village for illegal parking.
