Adderbury Parish Council - Environment Committee Terms of Reference

- 1. Meet every at least three months
- 2. Quorum 3 Councillors
- 3. The Membership of the Committee is established at the Annual Council Meeting or at a Parish Council meeting.
- 4. The Chairman and Vice-Chairman of the Committee be elected annually at the first meeting of the Committee in the municipal year.
- 5. The Committee be responsible for the following matters and will make recommendations to the Parish Council:
 - (a) litter collection, litter bins and dog waste bins;
 - (b) roads, footpaths, pavements and drainage issues;
 - (c) bus shelters;
 - (d) grass cutting (including liaison with Adderbury Green Association);
 - (e) street furniture:
 - (f) works to hedges and trees;
 - (g) general village maintenance;
 - (h) walled garden allotments and the inspections reports;
 - (i) Adderbury Cemetery and the inspection reports; and
 - (j) to identify the need for improved traffic calming in the village and, if a need is established, how it can be implemented and funded."
- 6. The Committee does not have any delegated powers, except to spend the funds in the Parish Council's budget for 2019/2020, which are available for traffic calming, subject to agreement by the Clerk and Responsible Financial Officer.
