Title of Report	Parking in The Rise
Summary	To consider writing to residents requesting that they do not park on the green in The Rise and discuss the parking issues at the junction with Banbury Road.
Recommendation	'No parking' signs be erected in the green in The Rise and residents be written to and asked not to park on the green.
	If Oxfordshire County Council highways is in agreement, double yellow lines be painted on the junction of The Rise and Banbury Road.
Reasons for the Recommendation	A number of residents park on the green in The Rise and it is not designated or suitable for parking.
	Parking at the junction of Banbury Road and The Rise has been an issue for some time, mainly with parents/carers from the Primary School parking their vehicles dangerously during drop-off and collection times. If OCC is in agreement to progress with this proposal, a Traffic Regulation Order would be needed and there would be a consultation process too.
Impact on Budget	Minimal – cost of signs and letters to residents.
	The costs for the Traffic Regulation Order could be incorporated into the traffic calming project.
Risks	If the parking on the green continues, then the grass and kerbstones could get damaged and it could result in the whole green space being used as a car park, when it is an amenity area for people to enjoy and children to play. It also makes it more difficult for the grass cutting contractor to do his job properly if vehicles are parking in the way.
	If the issue of the parking on the junction is not addressed, it could result in a child having an accident or cars having an accident. The road also gets blocked with cars double parking.
Background	The Primary School has been contacted about the issue of parents/carers parking dangerously on the junction of The Rise and Banbury Lane and the Head Teacher has contacted TVP and also written to parents.
	The Clerk to the Parish Council has also been in contact with TVP asking for the junction to the monitored.
