Summary	To receive a report on the Section 106 funds available to Adderbury.

Reasons for the Recommendation	To update Councillors on Section 106 funds available to Adderbury.
Impact on Budget	None on the Parish Council budget, S106 funds are held by Oxfordshire County Council and Cherwell District Council.
Risks	If funds are not spent within the set time period, they can be returned to the Developer.
Background	Planning obligations under Section 106 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended), commonly known as S106 agreements, are "a mechanism which make a development proposal acceptable in planning terms, that would not otherwise be acceptable".
	They are focused on site specific mitigation of the impact of development. S106 agreements are often referred to as 'developer contributions' along with highway contributions and the Community Infrastructure Levy.
	S106 funds are allocated by CDC during the Planning process to a number of areas: transport, education, museums, libraries, sport and recreation and many more.
	Each fund is subject to a legal agreement with specific wording as to how it may be spent by the local authority.
