Priorities discussed for the next few months Open spaces and ASBOs predominantly patrolling local parks mostly Thu/Fri/Sat/Sun on later shifts to disperse gatherings and deter crime. County line drugs- no changes in recent months, still an issue. Bodicote report an increase in discarded gas casings, described as legal highs. Advised to report if an issue locally and officers will do their best to patrol. Adderbury reported recent increase in eggings of houses, now seems to be passing cars, advised to report via 101 or if dangerous 999. "Nottingham knockers"- have to have a licence signed by Chief constable to operate in this area, if they become an issue advised to call and report as the police can move them on.
