Title of Report	Dog Waste Bin – bottom of Manor Road
Summary	At the bottom of Manor Road there is a popular dog walk across the fields to Bodicote & Bloxham. At the beginning of the track there is most days bagged dog mess left on the side of the track and into the fields. There is a dog waste bin on the Colin Butler Green at the beginning of Manor Road but dog walkers who are not at that end of the road tend to leave it by the gate before entering the fields. Some dog walkers collect the bagged mess on the way back but not everyone does. Daily you might see between 3-5 bags of mess left on the side. Some residents have also left notes on the gate at the bottom of Manor Road asking 'dog walkers to pick up their mess and to not put it in their home waste bins'.
Recommendation	I would like to recommend that at the bottom of Manor Road a small dog waste bin should be installed. It might be able to be installed on the public footpath post.
Reasons for the Recommendation	A bin located down the end of Manor Road would prevent bagged dog mess being left on the floor and residents getting cross with public putting dog mess in their home waste bins.
Impact on Budget	If approved the bin would need to be purchased by PC.
Risks	There might be complaints by residents who live down the bottom of the road about having a dog waste bin outside their house/drive. During hot weather if the bin is not emptied regularly then this will increase bugs / the smell in the area. Vandalism or accidents caused by drivers.
