Title of Report	Milton Road Project – To receive an update on the progress of the Milton Road new community and sport facilities following Planning Application 19/02796/F and Planning Consent 18/00220/F
Summary Report	All Pre-Commencement Conditions have been discharged by CDC so the PC can now go ahead with the preparation of the pitches for sport. This was due to start at beginning of October but was delayed due to the ongoing heavy rainfall. Ground conditions are now suitable so the company will start in the next few days.
	The Planning Application 19/02796/F has completed the consultation stage. All details have been accessible on CDC's Planning portal. The PC and WFAC websites have details and links to CDC. Also all the plans have been on show at the Library.
	As part of the Planning process further reports from Consultants eg for details of the SuDs on the building and lighting for the Muga, have been supplied to CDC.
	There has been a welcome number of comments in support of the Application, which has been consistent with the earlier community support shown at the two Parish Polls.
Recommendation	To accept the above report in full.
	To agree that the Chairman and Clerk continue progressing of the pitch area, working with Clark's Drainage (the company appointed by APC) and continue the management of the land.
	That the Chairman, Clerk and Vice Chairman continue working with the Architect to progress the Planning Application for Phase 2 of the project.
Reasons for the Recommendation	There have been a number of public consultations showing support from residents for this new community facility.
	The preparation of the pitches has already been agreed by APC and under the permitted Change of Use application, 18/00220/F.
	The application for Phase 2 is necessary to enable the project to move forward.
	Full planning permission for the building is necessary in order to apply for grants which will be needed to complete the actual build.

	A scheme to prepare and plant the pitches has been agreed by APC and
	a contractor appointed (Jan 2018 Minute: 135/17). The Chairman has
	continued discussions with D W Clark to commence preparations for the pitch area. These preparations were due to begin in October but
	had been postponed due to heavy rainfall.
	APC has already agreed to progressing with project including
	appointing an architect and QS.
	There have now been a number of consultations with residents on this
	project (including 2 Parish Polls, the most recent being May 13 th 2019)
	demonstrating public support which provides a mandate for the PC to
	move this project forward.
	The PC is acting under the Adderbury Neighbourhood Plans Policy AD18
	to provide new Leisure and Community Facilities for the residents of
	Adderbury.
	APC has previously agreed to progressing the Application for this 2 nd
	phase – the community building, highways entrance and car parking.
